Applications will be assessed on the following guidelines and from information provided in this application form

- **Professional attitude** – behaviour and approach to racing as well as other activities not necessarily associated with motorcycle sport.
- **Ability** – not necessarily running at top but ability to do so and future potential
- **Presentation** – able to ensure continued professional and well-groomed presentation at all times, both on and off the track.
- **Dedication and Commitment** to achieve their goals.
- Be under **25 years of age**
- **General attitude and sociability**
- Non factory-contracted, factory-backed satellite rider or otherwise major supported rider **from any ASC category**

- Motorcycling Australia

Scholarship Support Package

A support package will be provided for the scholarship recipient to assist them to compete in the ASC for the following year.

Conditions of Scholarship

The conditions for accepting the Reece Bancell scholarship are:

- If required, the rider will sign a 12-month contract with each supplier and abide by this at all times
- Rider agrees to contest the following year's ASC Championship, at all rounds
- Rider agrees to perform at his best at all times and to ensure all relevant sponsors are always represented and promoted in a professional manner
- Scholarship can be withdrawn at any time for any breach of the assessment guidelines and all scholarship items to be returned, within 7 days of notice of intention to withdraw.
